The Tynedale Beer Festival is held at the Tynedale Rugby Football Club, Tynedale Park, Corbridge, Northumberland NE45 5AY. The park provides some 35 acres of open flat land, mainly laid to grass.

Access by train:

The Festival entrance is approx 120m from Corbridge railway station which is on the main line from Newcastle to Carlisle. There is wheelchair access from the station and along a level asphalt road to the entrance.

Access by bus:

The Festival site entrance is approx. 250m from the bus stop serviced by the **685/X85** Arriva and the **10** Go North East buses. Access is via Station Road which is level and there is a level asphalt road within the site to the entrance of the Festival.

Access by car:

There is ample Blue Badge parking in car park at the entrance (100m) and by arrangement adjacent to the event main marquee. Wheelchair accessible taxis can also access the site.

The main Festival marquee is 100m from the car park and entrance, Access from the entrance to the main marquee is level and surfaced. The main marquee is 75m x 15m with side tents 39m x 12m for catering and the cider bar. Significant areas of the marquee are boarded for ease of movement for wheelchair users and ambulant disabled people. There is seating for people who cannot stand for long periods.

There is a disabled toilet within the Clubhouse. The Clubhouse is accessed via a ramp (fitted with a handrail) from the car park area. All doors have sufficient clearance for wheel chair access into the toilet. A key is not required. The toilet is fitted with an emergency alarm.

- Assistance dogs are welcome and water can be provided upon request.
- Assistance for people who cannot read the programme to understand what beers are available and fetch beers for people if necessary.
